

## Hunt Training

The Rio Salado Vizsla Club (RSVC) offers hunt training for club members and their dogs throughout the year.

RSVC Hunt Training sessions are held on Saturdays, from 8 AM to 4 PM at Pine Hill (see map below for directions). Members and their families are welcome to camp at the site, which is in the Coconino National Forest. Remember to bring water for you and your dog(s) and please remove all garbage. No facilities are available at the site. Always check the club's web site for updated information about hunt training sessions. Fire restrictions will most likely be in effect.

### Directions to the Pine Hill Training Site

From Phoenix, take I-17 north towards Flagstaff. Exit at Lake Mary Road (Exit 339, just before the I-40 interchange) and take a right. Drive about 25 miles to FR 125 (you will see a sign pointing to Kinnikinick Lake). Take a left onto FR 125 and drive approximately 5 miles to FR 82. Turn right onto FR 82, drive approximately 1/10th mile, and look for blaze orange "Vizsla Hunt Test" signs pointing to the training site. Lake Mary Road is paved; other FR's are not paved, but suitable for passenger cars in most weather. GPS Coordinates N34 56.435 W111 21.734.

### Field Trial Training Permit

The Arizona Game and Fish Department requires a permit for hunt training. There is no fee for the permit, which is good for one calendar year. An application for this permit can be printed from the club's web site at [www.rsvc.net](http://www.rsvc.net) under "Hunt Training."
