## **VERSATILITY CERTIFICATE PROGRAM**

RSVC will hold a Versatility at Mormon Lake the weekend of July 17 & 18, 2004. We will have all 3 segments - field, conformation and obedience. Versatility entry fees are modest - field \$15, conformation and obedience \$6. Deborah Sanders is chairing this event. Please note that Deborah will be out of town June 30 to July 11. If you want to enter, please complete the enclosed entry form and mail to Deborah. We prefer advance entries but will accept entries the day of the event. Please get your entries in soon. We will also have field training on July 17th (contact Jim DeWoody for field training.)

Here is a summary of the Versatility Program. For the full rules and regulations, go to our club website and click on the Versatility Certificate button.

The Versatility Program is a Vizsla Club of America (VCA) event. It combines conformation (show), obedience, and field into one event. The Versatility Program showcases our versatile Vizslas in all three areas. If your dog passes each segment three times, you will be awarded a Versatility Certificate and be able to use the letters VC after your dog's name.

**Eligibility** -- Vizsla must be AKC registered. For the field and obedience segments, your dog must be at least 6 months old. For conformation your dog must be at least 12 months old. There is no maximum age.

Neutered and spayed dogs are eligible. Males whose testicles have not descended into the scrotum (cryptorchid) or who only have one descended testicle (monorchid) are not eligible.

Bitches in season are eligible and will be scheduled last.

**Test Segments** -- All segments are pass or fail. You can only run under a judge once in a given segment.

**Conformation** -- Dog is judged on whether it is an overall good representative of the Vizsla breed and whether it reflects the qualities of a purebred Vizsla.

**Measurement** -- This is part of the conformation segment. Dogs must be measured each time tested. At least one measurement must be when dog is 18 months or older.

**Obedience** -- Dog must perform a simple "L" pattern on and off lead, stand alone for the judge to examine him/her, come to you when called, and stay in place in a group for 3 minutes.

**Field** -- Dog must exhibit a natural desire to hunt, locate and point game, and retrieve game 3/4 way back to you. Dog may be collared on the flush and shot.

If you already have a Conformation Championship, or an Obedience title of CD, CDX, or UD, or a Senior or Master Hunter title, you can get a bye on the applicable segments. Those other titles count toward your Versatility Certificate.

## MEET OUR NEW RESCUE COORDINATOR: TRISHA FLEISCHER

Today I have three Vizslas and two of them came to me through Rescue! My third, a male, is a 13 week old puppy from Marge Mehagian.

My very first dog, Kaiser, was out of a dog bred by Nancy Boggs Heinold and Dan Montambo. I met Dan Montambo at the Detroit Dog Show in the fall of 1995. It was a benched show and we were going to decide between a Weim and a Vizsla. I had never met a Vizsla and when we met Dan's dog, Hunter, it was love at first site. We got our first Vizsla puppy in the summer of 1996 from Jill Day of Grand Blanc, Michigan. When we divorced in 2000 and we couldn't split Kaiser in half, after a year of "joint" custody, we decided to keep him in Michigan with my ex since he was trained to hunt and loved living in the country. But I was hooked on the breed! I was looking for a puppy when I learned of Rescue from Nancy Heinold and got connected with Carolyn DiFiore in Michigan. Carolyn introduced me to an owner in Wisconsin who had a three year old female. The owner's husband had gone to jail, they had no home and she just couldn't care for Nakita as much as she wanted to keep her. I adopted Nakita in Sept 2000 without her having to go into a foster home. I think it was mutual; we saved each other's lives in so many ways! She got into bed (under the covers literally) with me the first night in the Wisconsin motel before we flew home together the next day! She has been by my side ever since! With Nakita, I truly learned the meaning of "if you love a Vizsla, it will live on top of your head"!!!!

I moved with Nakita from Michigan to Arizona in August 2001. I wanted a second dog to keep her company since I would be gone at my new office every day. I contacted Rita Prindle in Colorado since I could not find a rescue person on the web for Arizona. That's when Rita told me about Amy Smith. I made contact with Amy before my move and she told me about a trio of Vizslas that had been rescued from a shelter in New Mexico in May of 2001. The only male of the infamous New Mexico Trio, Max, was a great fit with Nakita. Amy Smith brought Max back to health but needed a permanent home for him. Max and I fell in love instantly at the first meeting and Max came home with me in September 2001. Max and Kita took some time getting to know one another, but like a great friendship, it grew stronger every day! They have been inseparable ever since. They even sleep tail to tail on the sofa.

Kita is epileptic and had her first seizure 30 days after coming to me. We are controlling her episodes with medication to less than one a year now!!!! Max had a malignant tumor when he came to me, about the size of a grape, in the corner of his left eye. He had surgery and he went two years without a recurrence. He has lots of moles, likely from his time living on concrete outdoors in the sun for 6+ years in NM. We found another malignant tumor this February. He is now participating in a clinical trial with the Univ. of Wisconsin, a vaccine trial for melanoma. He will be done in about eight weeks with the trial. He has clear lungs and abdomen, no metastases and is otherwise in excellent 10 year old health! He also had FHO surgery in December 2002 on the right hip. He won't run a marathon but can get on the sofa and play like he's half his age, and his spirit and stamina makes me cry when I think of the condition he was in when I got him.

We used to joke that he didn't speak English. He had never had a toy, eaten a treat or been on a leash! When I think of the transformation in Max, and let me tell you, little did I know what I was taking on when I brought him home, somehow the nobility of the breed and their unconditional love helped us overcome all the typical rescue issues. He urinated in the house from fear or a raised voice or loud laughter, barked at the tiniest of noises, was desperately afraid of men and hand shy to the point that he literally cried at the sight of a man, and pawed at every cabinet door for food. I put 15 lbs on him, gave him treats and toys, let him snooze on the sofa, walked him daily and slowly introduced new people. He stopped chewing his way into the cabinets because he wasn't hungry anymore. He finally learned English. I fell in love with him all over again when I saw his determination coming through hip surgery. He was taking every advantage of the new life he had waited so long for!

So I am rambling on telling you all of this because I think I have gotten the greatest satisfaction and love from Max and Kita and cannot think of a better way to repay their devotion than to help other dogs and people connect. My experience with the challenges, training and patience needed for adoption, along with my flexible work schedule, computer, research and business skills makes me eager and qualified. Oh and I love having a Velcro Vizsla by my side, and definitely know what it takes to be a good Vizsla rescue mom or dad.

I have great resources here with the RSVC. I know there is some history with previous rescue assistance and would hope to be able to work in this position WITH them.
