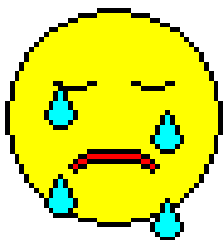

## PERMITS

It's time to send in your training permit applications to AZ Game & Fish. Please see the last newsletter on our website to download a copy of the permits. PLEASE NOTE that they need to be mailed to two different offices. IMPORTANT – With your last permit was a small yellow card with your name and id number on it (hope you kept it.) You will need to write the number on the permit application line that says "Department ID Number." The number is the same for both applications. If you don't have the yellow card anymore, then call one of the offices and ask for your number to write on your application. The training permits are free.

You will also need a State Land permit to go on any land owned by the State of Arizona. One permit covers the entire state. You need one to train at the Orme area. Since the permit is a multi-part form, you need to call the State Land Dept. and ask them to mail you a Recreational Use Permit. There is a fee - \$15 for individuals or \$20 for a family (husband and wife can get the family one.) The phone number to call is 602-542-4621.

Titles earned before the owner’s membership are not eligible for awards. The owner must be a member in the year the title was earned as well as in the year the award is given. Awards will be presented at the Annual Meeting/Awards Banquet. If you are unable to come to the banquet, please make arrangements to have your awards picked up by someone else or at another club event. **Awards will not be mailed.**

The award is a wooden plaque with the RSVC medallion. There is space for six engraved title bars. Each plaque may have several dogs represented. If you have already filled a plaque, you must complete the appropriate area on this form to receive a new plaque. Multiple titles earned during the year will be included on one title bar for each dog. Any titles earned before January 1<sup>st</sup> of that year will also appear.

**Use a separate form for each dog. This form may be copied.**

To complete the form –

List dog’s full name, including titles earned before January 1,2003.

List separately the titles earned in 2003 along with the date and place the title was completed. For example: As of December 31, 2002 my dog’s name and titles were – Ch. Big Dog, CD. During 2003 he earned his JH at the RSVC August Hunt Test and his CDX at Sahuaro State Kennel Club in November. He also passed his versatility field in August to complete the last requirement for his VC. His title bar will read: Ch. Big Dog, CDX, JH, VC.
